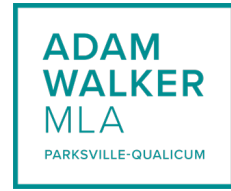

OCEANSIDE HEALTH CARE TOWN HALLS: EVERYONE IS INVITED

QUALICUM BEACH, July 11, 2024 – Adam Walker, MLA for Parksville-Qualicum will hold a series of town hall meetings in Nanoose Bay, Parksville, and Qualicum Beach to discuss primary health care in Oceanside, ways to work together, and give residents the opportunity to ask questions and join this important conversation.

“Right now, approximately 12,000 of our Oceanside friends and neighbours are waiting to be connected to a primary care provider. We have no walk-in clinics in the area and a large number of seniors that cannot easily travel to seek the medical care they need. While important work has been done to increase access to healthcare, we know there is more to do provincially and locally to ensure all Oceanside residents can get the care they need.” said Adam Walker.

The upcoming town halls will provide a forum to explore ways to enhance access to health care and offer an opportunity for the public to ask questions and share their perspectives.
